2023 SPECTACULAR DAY INFORMATION

EVENT STRUCTURE

- There will be three sessions.
- The sessions will be created once all teams have registered and the divisions can be determined.

EARLYBIRE

- Spectators and teams will be permitted to remain in the gym throughout each session.
- There will be sections of the bleachers reserved for teams on the same side as their spectators.
- It is recommended that you do not allow cheerleaders to have personal items with them. CCL cannot be responsible for your team's items as you transition to and from warm-ups.
- The gym will be cleared at the conclusion of awards after each session. Spectators will not be permitted on the performance floor.
- Directors and Coaches will be dismissed with their teams after awards, then the spectators will be dismissed. Everyone will exit the doors on the football stadium side of the gym. See the map on page #4.
- Spectators will not be permitted to leave personal items in the gym (save seats) in between sessions.
- Spectators and teams will not be permitted to exit via the doors they enter.
- There will be a music check before each session. Coaches should designate someone to check their music just in case their team is in warm-ups during that time.

SPECTATOR ADMISSION

- Spectator wristbands must be purchased in advance.
 - None will be sold at the door.
 - There is a section for wristbands within the event registration.
 - There are two ways to purchase additional spectator wristbands:
 - Send an email with the number needed to <u>leaguetreasurer.ccl@gmail.com</u> until 10/25/2023. You will be invoiced for the total amount and arrangements can be made for you to pick-up your order.
 - Bring a check to the Thomas Dale High School Gymnasium on 10/28/2023 @10AM.
 - 10/28/2023 will be the last day you can pick-up and/or purchase wristbands.
 - The cost is \$15 per person. One payment from your association is required when purchasing wristbands. CCL will not accept payments from spectators directly.
 - Spectators will not be permitted to enter the building without the Spectator wristband.
 Exceptions:
 - CCL Cheerleaders that are not performing will be admitted for free if they are in uniform.
 - Children 4 and under are admitted free.
 - CQL and CBL players wearing their team's jersey are free.
 - No wristbands will be sold after 10/28/2023.
- Spectators will be permitted in the gym for all performances. We will not be clearing the gym between performances.

2023 SPECTACULAR DAY INFORMATION

- Enter the side of the building assigned to the team that you wish to see (reference the performance order once it is released); either **Door #11** (South Entrance) or **Door #13** (North Entrance). See the map on page #4.
- The entrances to the building must remain clear. Do not block the entrance doors.
- Spectators must exit the gym at the end of each session at the conclusion of the awards presentation. They will not be permitted to leave personal items (save seats) for the subsequent sessions.
- No noise makers allowed (i.e., air horns, cowbells, et al).
- Park in the designated, marked parking spaces.
 - Do not park in the lot between the baseball field and Door #13
 - Towing will be enforced at the owners' expense for cars parked illegally.

TEAM CHECK-IN

- For teams that will come to the gym before their check-in, enter through Door #10.
- Teams will check-in at door #22. See the map on page #4.
- Coaches should follow the performance order schedule and check-in at the time assigned to their team. Note: The final performance order will be published no later than 10/25/2023.
- Only Coaches, Directors and cheerleaders listed on the Spectacular roster for the team checking
 in, will be allowed through the check-in doors.
- Spectators, non-competing cheerleaders, children of Coaches and Directors, photographers, music helpers, equipment carriers, Association mascots, etc. will have to enter via the appropriate spectator door and they will need to have on a CCL Spectator wristband (if applicable).
- Teams should not block the doors because they will not be permitted to enter the building until their check-in time.
- Teams will proceed directly to warm-ups when they check-in.
- No glitter is allowed.

WARM-UPS

• After check-in, teams will be escorted to the first warm-up mat where they will have 4 minutes for stretching. No stunting or tumbling is allowed in this area.

THOMAS DALE H.S.

- Teams will then transition to the second warm-up mat in the auxiliary gym where they will have 4 minutes.
- Teams will move to the third, and final warm-up mat in the auxiliary gym where they will have 4 minutes.
- Unless there are delays communicated to you by the CCL attendant, your warm-up times begin
 and end at the times designated on the schedule. Please be cognizant of those times and ensure
 that you transition your teams in an efficient manner.

PERFORMANCE/AWARDS

- Teams will perform facing the direction indicated on the performance order document. Teams will enter the SOUTH gym doors if their spectator entrance is "NORTH". Teams will enter the NORTH gym doors if their spectator entrance is "SOUTH". Spectacular escorts and volunteers will help direct teams.
- Since everyone will be permitted to enter the gym, performances will not be recorded.
- Sarah Dearmon, Kristie Oliver, and Last Year Senior awards will be presented following each team's performance.
- Division awards will be presented at the end of each session. Spectators are permitted to remain
 in the gym during awards.

DISMISSAL

- When instructed, exit via the stadium-side gym doors opposite from where you entered the gym. See the map on page #4.
- Parents will not be permitted to come onto the performance floor after awards to retrieve their cheerleader. They must meet the teams outside the building. It is recommended that you designate an area for your parents to meet so that your cheerleaders are accounted for and you can dismiss them safely.
